Articulation Agreement

Purpose:

The purpose of this agreement is to provide students at North Island College, enrolled in the Fine Arts Diploma, the opportunity to transfer into a Bachelor's degree at Emily Carr University of Art + Design.

Terms and Conditions:

(1) Transfer to the Bachelor of Fine Arts (Visual Arts, Critical and Cultural Practices)

- (a) Students who complete the Fine Arts Diploma at North Island College with a cumulative grade point average (GPA) of B (3.00 on a 4.00 scale) or higher will automatically be accepted into year three (3) of the Bachelor of Fine Arts (BFA) (Visual Arts, Critical and Cultural Practices) degree program at Emily Carr University.
- (b) Students with a cumulative GPA between 2.00 and 2.99 will be considered for admission to year three (3) of the BFA on the basis of their academic standing and a portfolio review.

(2) Transfer to the BFA (Film + Video + Integrated Media, Illustration, Photography) and the Bachelor of Design (Communication, Industrial, Interaction) and the Bachelor of Media (Animation, Interactive + Social Media Arts)

- (a) Students who have completed the Fine Arts Diploma at North Island College with a GPA of C (2.00 on a 4.00 scale) or higher will be considered for admission to the above noted programs on the basis of their academic standing and a portfolio review. It should be noted that these programs have competitive entry, and therefore the portfolio should reflect work that is consistent with the intended major.

(3) Credit Assignment and Deficiencies

Based on the North Island College Fine Arts Diploma program, students are eligible to receive up to 63 credits on transfer (depending on the major chosen). Students will be required to make up any academic deficiencies from the first or second year of the Emily Carr degree program, including, but not limited to, 6


credits of first year University English Literature and Composition plus 6 credits of first year Survey of Western Art History.

The terms and conditions of the agreement, and the continuation of the agreement, will be reviewed annually by both parties.


